

Rear Brake

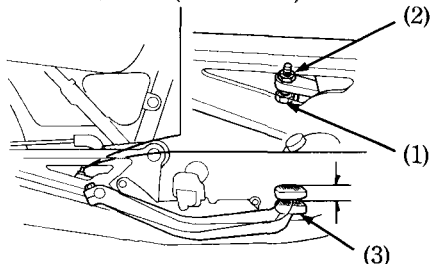
1. Place the motorcycle on its side stand.
2. The stopper bolt (1) is provided to allow adjustment of the pedal height.

To adjust the pedal height, loosen the lock nut (2) and turn the stopper bolt. Tighten the lock nut.

3. Measure the distance the rear brake pedal (3) moves before the brake starts to take hold.

Free play should be:

20–30 mm (0.8–1.2 in)



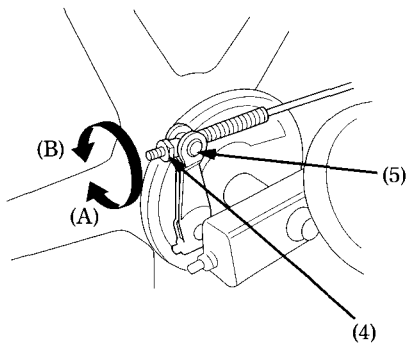
(1) Stopper bolt
(2) Lock nut

(3) Rear brake pedal

Make free play adjustments by turning the adjusting nut (4) at the brake arm.

NOTE:

- * Make sure the cut-out on the adjusting nut is seated on the brake arm pin (5) after making final free play adjustment.
