

5. Obey all federal and local law regulations.

Use the headlight anytime while riding to make the motorcycle more visible to other motorists.

6. It is recommended that you become familiar with your new HONDA CB750 by riding in an uncongested area before riding on the public roadways.
7. Be sure to signal when making a turn or changing lanes.
8. Do not ride on the roadway shoulder. Remember a motorcyclist should always preserve nature and respect property.

■ LOADING AND ACCESSORIES

WARNING: The addition of accessories and cargo to this motorcycle can create an unsafe condition by changing the motorcycle's stability, handling characteristics, and decreasing the safe operating speed. The factory cannot test each accessory and all possible combinations to make specific recommendations. The operator must be personally responsible for his safety and the safety of others involved. Be aware that extreme care must be taken when selecting and installing accessories, adding cargo, and riding a motorcycle equipped with accessories and cargo. These general guidelines are given to aid the operator in deciding whether or how to equip his motorcycle.

1. Keep cargo weight concentrated low and close to the motorcycle to minimize the change in the motorcycle's center of gravity. Distribute the weight equally on both sides of the machine.
