- Remove the carburetor by removing the bolts and nuts. Unscrew the carburetor cap and pull out the throttle valve.
- 4. Remove the float chamber.
- 5. Remove the standard main jet (1) No. 98, and install the high altitude main jet. Reinstall the float chamber
- Screw in the pilot screw as shown in the table on page 48.
- Install the carburetor. Make sure the drain screw is turned fully clockwise and turn the fuel valve ON.
- 8. Start the engine. Adjust the idle speed and pilot screw (page 47).


* Adjust the idle speed and pilot screw at high altitude to ensure proper high altitude operation.

Removal: Below 5,000 ft (1,500 m)

- 1. Follow installation steps 1-4.
- 2. Reinstall the original No. 98 main jet.
- 3. Screw out the pilot screw to original position.
- 4. Reinstall the carburetor. Adjust the idle speed and pilot screw (page 47).
