- 3. If the cable adjuster is threaded out near its limit or the correct free play cannot be obtained using the cable adjuster (3), a major adjustment must be made. Loosen the lock nut (4) and turn in the cable abjuster (3) completely. Tighten the lock nut (4) and pull on the dust cover (2).
- 4. Install the handlebar cover securely. (Insert the fuel tank cap breather tube in the hole in the handlebar cover securely).

## NOTE:

If proper adjustment cannot be obtained or the clutch does not work correctly, the cable or clutch friction discs may be worn. See your authorized Honda dealer.

## Other Checks:

Check the clutch cable for kinks or signs of wear that could cause sticking or failure. Lubricate the clutch cable with a commercially available cable lubricant to prevent premature wear and corrosion.


