
Brake fluid must be added to the reservoir whenever the fluid level begins to reach the lower level mark (1).

- 1. Remove the screws (2), reservoir cap (3), diaphragm plate (4) and diaphragm (6).
- 2. Fill the reservoir with DOT 3 or DOT 4 BRAKE FLUID from a sealed container up to the upper level mark (6).
- Reinstall the removed parts in the reverse order of removal.

Other Checks:

Make sure there are no fluid leaks Check for deterioration or cranks in the hose and fittings.
