- 3. Remove the screws (1) (Fig. 4-5) and remove the air cleaner assembly (2) from the air cleaner housing.
- 4. Unscrew the clamp (3) and remove the mounting bracket (4).
- 5. Remove the air cleaner (5) from the air cleaner body (6).



- 6. Gently wash the air cleaner in clean, non-flammable (high flash point) solvent such as kerosene—not gasoline. Allow the air cleaner to dry throughly before applying oil. A wet air cleaner will not fully absorb the oil.

HOW TO AVOID THE HAZARD
