

Engine Oil & Filter

- 4. Remove the oil filter bolt (7) and oil filter cover (8). Let the remaining oil drain out.
- 5. Remove the oil filter (9) from the cover.
- 6. Remove the spring (10) and washer (11). Do not discard the washer with the old oil filter.
- 7. Discard the oil filter in an approved manner (page 238).
- 8. Check the O-rings (12) are in good condition and then insert a new oil filter to the oil filter cover.
 - Use only the Honda Genuine oil filter or a filter of equivalent quality specified for your model. Using the wrong Honda filter or a non-Honda filter which is not of equivalent quality may cause engine damage.
- 9. Install the oil filter cover and tighten the oil filter bolt. Make sure the oil filter bolt is tightened securely to the specified torque.


Oil filter bolt torque:

13 lbf-ft (18 N·m, 1.8 kgf·m)
