## **Storing Your Honda**

## **Preparation for Storage**

Refer to Safety Precautions on page 97.

This procedure requires a means for draining and disposing of drained fuel (page 184).

- 1. Change the engine oil and filter (page 117).
- 2. Make sure the cooling system is filled with a 50/50% antifreeze solution (page 124).
- 3. Fill the fuel tank. Make sure the fuel fill cap is properly installed.
- 4. Check that the fuel valve is OFF.
- 5. Drain the carburetor into an approved petrol container and dispose of it in an approved manner (page 184).
  - If storage will last longer than one month, carburetor draining is important, to assure proper performance after storage.

## **AWARNING**

Petrol is highly flammable and explosive. You can be burned or seriously injured when handling fuel.

- Stop the engine and keep heat, sparks and flame away.
- Handle fuel only outdoors.
- Wipe up spills immediately.
