
Coolant Temperature Meter

The coolant temperature meter (1) shows coolant temperature digitally.

Temperature Display

Below 34°C	"" is displayed.
Between 35°C and 132°C	Actual coolant tempera- ture is indicated.
Above 132°C	The display will remain "132°C".



Overheating Message
When the coolant temperature reaches
122°C, the display begins to flash and coolant temperature indicator (2) goes on. If this occurs, stop the engine and check the reserve tank coolant level. Read pages 32 - 33 and do not ride the motorcycle until the problem has been corrected. If the coolant temperature reaches 122°C

while the odometer and tripmeter display is selected, the display will automatically switch to coolant temperature.

NOTICE

Exceeding maximum running temperature may cause serious engine damage.
