

TROUBLESHOOTING

Crankshaft noisy

- Worn connecting rod big end bearing.
- Bent connecting rod.
- Worn crankshaft main journal bearing.

Jumps out of gear

- Shift fork bent or damaged.
- Shift fork shaft bent.
- Shift claw bent.
- Gear engagement dogs or slots worn.
- Shift drum cam grooves damaged.

Hard to shift

- Incorrect clutch adjustment.
- Shift fork bent or damaged.
- Shift fork shaft bent.
