Starter Motor Operates But Engine Does Not Start

Check the following items:

- Check the correct engine starting sequence. ▶ P. 27
- Check that there is gasoline in the fuel tank.
- Check if the PGM-FI malfunction indicator lamp (MIL) is on.
 - If the indicator lamp is on, contact your dealer as soon as possible.

Starter Motor Does Not Operate

Check the following items:

- Check the correct engine starting sequence. P. 27
- Make sure engine stop switch is in the (Run) position.
 P. 24
- Check for a blown fuse. P. 101
- Check for a loose battery connection
 (≥ P. 53) or battery terminal corrosion
 (≥ P. 41).
- Check the condition of the battery. ■ P. 97

If the problem continues, have your vehicle inspected by your dealer.
