

You and the Environment

Owning and riding a motorcycle can be a marvellous experience, but it has its share of responsibility in protecting the environment.

Choose mild cleaners

Use biodegradable detergents when washing your motorcycle. Avoid aerosol spray cleaners that contain chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) that damage the atmosphere's protective ozone layer.

Recycle waste

Put oil and other toxic waste in approved containers and take them to a recycling centre. Call your town council or environmental service to find out the location of your closest recycling centre and for instructions on how to dispose of waste that cannot be recycled. Do not deposit used engine oil in household rubbish or pour it down the drain or on the ground. Used oil, petrol, coolant and cleaning solvents contain poisons that can harm urban rubbish collection workers and pollute our drinking water, lakes, rivers, and oceans.
