## Is Your Vehicle Ready to Drive?

Driveshafts	Inspect the driveshafts and boots for damage, tears, or leaks. If any tears are found, see your Honda dealer.
Steering gearbox and boots	Check the steering to make sure it turns smoothly in both directions. Check for any tears in the boots. If any tears are found, see your Honda dealer.
Underbody	If the vehicle was last driven in deep grass or a brushy area, look for and remove any debris. Check for any visible dents or cracks. If any dents or cracks are found, see your Honda dealer.
Air Cleaner Housing Drain Tube	Check for deposits in the drain tube. If necessary, clean the tube (page 120) and check the air cleaner housing.
Suspension	Check the condition of all suspension components. Be sure to look for bends or oil leaks in the cushion damper.
Lights	Make sure the headlights, tail lights, and brake lights are working properly.
Controls	Check that all driving controls, including the accelerator pedal, brake pedal, parking brake lever, drive mode select lever, and the shift lever are operating smoothly.
Exhaust System	Make sure no flammable materials or debris are sticking to the exhaust system. If any flammable materials or debris is found, remove it. Start the engine and listen for any exhaust leaks.
