
# If a Fuse Blows

#### Main Fuse Access

#### **UNDER SEAT**



- (2) fuse holder assembly
- (3) fuse holder
- 1. To prevent an accidental short circuit, turn the ignition switch OFF (O) before checking or replacing the fuse.
- 2. To access the fuse, remove the seat (page 86).
- 3. Remove the fuse holder assembly (2).
- 4. Pull the old fuse out of the fuse holder (3). If it is blown, install the spare main fuse.

If you do not have a replacement fuse with the proper rating for the circuit, install one with a lower rating.

## **NOTICE**

Replacing a fuse with one that has a higher rating greatly increases the chance of damage to the electrical system.

5. Install the fuse holder assembly and seat.
