Starting & Stopping the Engine

Flooded Engine

If the engine fails to start after repeated attempts, it may be flooded with excess fuel. To clear a flooded engine:

- 1. Move the engine stop switch to OFF (\boxtimes).
- 2. Push the choke knob right all the way to fully OFF.
- 3. Open the throttle fully.
- 4. Press the start button for 5 seconds.
- 5. Wait 10 seconds, then turn the engine stop switch to RUN (\cap).
- 6. Repeat the *'Normal Air Temperature''* starting procedure, but don't use the choke.
