4	right turn signal indicator (green)	Flashes when the right turn signal operates.
5	PGM-FI malfunction indicator lamp (MIL) (amber)	Lights when there is any abnormality in the PGM-FI (Programmed Fuel Injection) system. Should also light for a few seconds and then go off when the ignition switch is turned ON and the engine stop switch is at RUN. If the indicator comes on at any other time, reduce speed and take your motorcycle to your dealer as soon as possible. <i>Lamp Check</i> .
6	low oil pressure indicator (red)	Lights when engine oil pressure is low enough to cause engine damage. If the low oil pressure indicator lights during operation, pull safely to the side of the road. See page 179 for instructions and cautions. <i>Lamp Check</i> .
7	neutral indicator (green)	Lights when the transmission is in neutral.
8	high coolant temperature indicator (red)	Lights when the coolant is over the specified temperature. If the indicator comes on, pull safely to the side of the road. See page 177 for instructions and cautions.
