

Pre-ride Inspection

To ensure safety, it is your responsibility to perform a pre-ride inspection and make sure that any problem you find is corrected. A pre-ride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tire, can be a major inconvenience.

Check the following items before you get on your motorcycle:

- Fuel level-Fill fuel tank when necessary. ➔P.25
- Throttle-Check for smooth opening and full closing in all steering positions. ➔P.74
- Engine oil level-Add engine oil if necessary. Check for leaks. ➔P.52
- Drive chain-Check condition and slack, adjust and lubricate if necessary.
- Brakes-Check operation;
Front and Rear: check brake fluid level and pads wear. ➔P.62, 63

- Lights and horn-Check that lights, indicators and horn function properly.
- Engine stop switch-Check for proper function. ➔P.20
- Clutch-Check operation;
Adjust freeplay if necessary.
- Side stand ignition cut-off system-Check for proper function. ➔P.64
- Wheels and tires-Check condition, air pressure and adjust if necessary. ➔P.44
